

Title: Exhibition and Display

Curriculum : Art

Grade Level Span : 9-12

Purpose: To exhibit artwork and compile feedback information from the audience.

Description: To exhibit artwork with consideration of the audience, write an artist statement and develop a critique sheet to compile a feedback sheet. Using the theme related works created from the units during the school year -- mat and exhibit their best 3 works.
