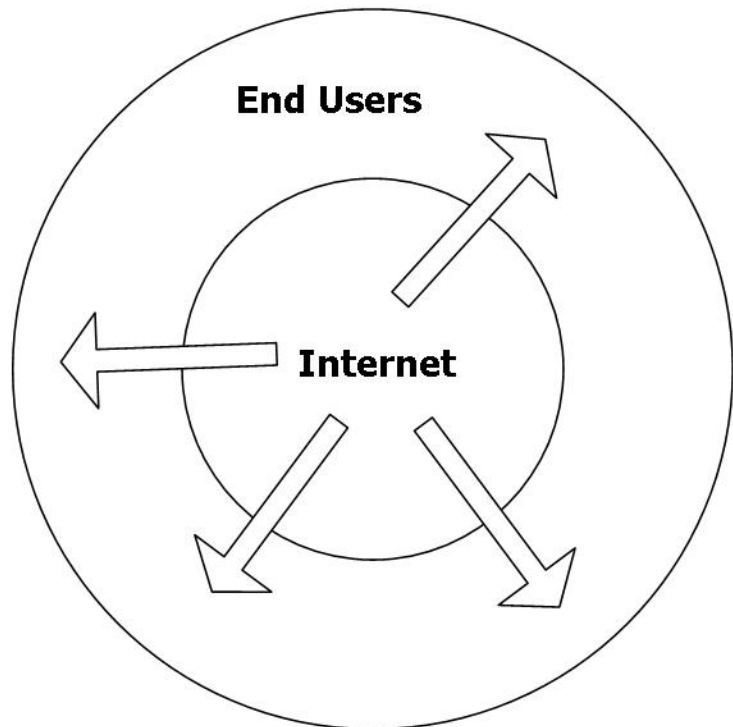


Web 2.0 Resources

websites are most often published using
HTML software programs and are not
editable by the end user.

Data flows from user to user. Open
source software and web-based tools
allow end users to easily collaborate,
network, and communicate and up-
load and share information in multi-
media formats.
